**How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.**

**(Acts 10:38 KJV)**

*Thursday July 1*

There is a time when Jesus healed a person who was dumb and possessed by a devil and scripture records that everyone was caught with fear and amazement because such things had never been done in Israel before {Matthew 9:33}. During the old testament the complete glory of God and his very image hadn't manifested yet. Scripture tells us that there was not yet a way into the holy of holies by then {Hebrews 9:8}. No one could approach God directly and the High Priest could only enter into his presence once a year. The coming of Jesus changed

everything. It was God coming down himself to pour out his heart. That's why Jesus is called Emmanuel which means 'God with us' {Matthew 1:23}. # God still heals today

**Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.**

**(1 Peter 2:24 KJV)**

*Friday July 2*

Scripture says Jesus was wounded for our transgressions at the cross. This means healing is part of the work of Salvation. If God is still forgiving us our sins today and offering us salvation in the name of Jesus then God is still healing people also. God's healing power didn't cease in the bible. # God is still at work today

**So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them , and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.**

**(Mark 16:19-20 KJV)**

*Saturday July 3*

Wow! I love this one. Jesus having ascended to heaven he is still working miracles in our lives today. Though in heaven he is still working miracles. Child of God he did not leave us alone but he left the Holy Spirit to dwell within us. Paul testifies to the Galatians saying, "*He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? (Galatians 3:5 KJV)*". Even years later after the ascension of Jesus, Paul testifies that God was still working miracles in believers. God is constantly working miracles in our lives even today. The only reason why you might



not be experiencing these miracles is because you are seeking them by works and not by faith. You don't need to work for God's healing. It's already paid for by the strips of Jesus. All you have to do is receive the blessing by faith.

### *Prayer*

Precious Father I thank you for your Spirit which you have given us. You constantly work miracles in us and around us. The resurrection power of Christ is made manifest in my life and the same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead gives life to my mortal body.

# The body of sin is dead

**If Christ lives in you, though your [natural] body is dead because of sin, your spirit is alive because of righteousness [which He provides]. And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you.**

**(Romans 8:10-11 AMP)**

*Sunday July 4*

What Paul is saying here is that if Christ lives in you, your body is dead because of sin but your spirit is alive because of righteousness (not our own righteousness but the righteousness which is of God through faith in Christ).

Why is Paul saying if we are born again the body is dead because of sin? This is because when we got born again we were baptized into Christ. So when Christ was crucified in the flesh we were also crucified with him. Why is this important? Because of what Romans 6 says; *"Certainly not!*

*How can we, the very ones who died to sin, continue to live in it any longer? Or are you ignorant of the fact that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? (Romans 6:2-3 AMP)*” You need to understand that you are no longer a sinner because you died to sin with Jesus at the cross and with that revelation walk in righteousness.

*Prayer*

I am no longer a sinner. I am crucified with Christ and dead to sin and the world. I proclaim this in the name of Jesus. Amen.

*Word Power*

Galatians 6:14

# The life giving Spirit

**And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit, who lives in you.**

**(Romans 8:11 AMP)**

*Monday July 5*

The Holy Spirit empowers us to live a righteous life. Without the Holy Spirit we wouldn't be able to meet up with the righteousness standards of God. That's why Paul said we who walk after the Spirit are the ones who have the righteousness of the Law fulfilled in our lives Not those who walk after the flesh. If you are in Christ (Born again) the Holy Spirit lives in you. The presence of the Holy Spirit in you affects your body. Yes! The presence of the Holy Spirit in your spirit can affect your body. That's why our theme scripture said, *"He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies*

*through His Spirit, who lives in you.*” The Holy Spirit gives life and health to our bodies. As you walk in the truth of God’s word the Holy Spirit will bear to the truth. Continue walking in the reality that Jesus took away both your sins and sicknesses at the cross and you will experience health and peace in your life and bodies.

*Prayer*

Jesus took away both my sins and sicknesses at the cross. I walk in forgiveness of sins and health in Jesus name.

*Word Power*

John 7:37-39

# Healing and the forgiveness of sins

**And he is pierced for our transgressions, Bruised for our iniquities, The chastisement of our peace [is] on him, And by his bruise there is healing to us.**

**(Isaiah 53:5 YLT98)**

*Tuesday July 6*

Jesus suffered for all our sins. He paid the price for our sins past, future and present. Isaiah tells us that the chastisement of our peace was upon him. This means Jesus paid for your peace. This is why God talks a lot about peace in the New testament. Paul even calls the gospel the gospel of peace {Ephesians 6:15}. I want you also to know that even as Christ paid for your sins so also has he paid for your peace and healing. In Romans this is what Paul says, "*for I am not ashamed of the good news of the Christ,*

*for it is the power of God to salvation (soteria) to every one who is believing, both to Jew first, and to Greek. (Romans 1:16 YLT98)*” The Greek word translated to ‘salvation’ is the word ‘soteria’ and its an all compassing word which means restoration, healing and preservation. The same way by the gospel God wants you to know he has forgiven your sins is also the same way he wants you to know that Christ has paid for your sickness and peace.

### Prayer

Christ paid for my sins and sicknesses. I walk in health, peace and forgiveness in Jesus name.

### Word Power

Acts 10:38

# God is willing to heal you

**And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.**

**(Matthew 8:2-3 KJV)**

*Wednesday July 7*

This poor man knew that Jesus had the power to heal the sick but he wasn't sure if he was willing to heal him. Some of us we are like this man. We know that God is all powerful but we are not really sure if God is willing to heal and transform our lives. Jesus gave the best response ever to this. He said, "I will". Child of God besides knowing that God has the ability to heal you he also wants you to know that he is willing to heal you. You don't need to ask worried or for the sake of just asking Jesus to heal you. He is already willing to heal you and he is just waiting for you to receive his healing. Simply receive his healing in your



life. If you are sick with any disease or you feel like you are being oppressed by demons simply say Jesus I receive your healing in your name.

I thank you Lord for you reached out to me even before I knew it. I receive all your blessing upon my life and Divine Health in Jesus name.

# Shalom

**And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.**

**(Philippians 4:7 KJV)**

*Thursday July 8*

The Hebrew word for peace is shalom and its an all encompassing word for peace, wholeness and rest. If you are dwelling or walking in shalom it means you are at rest. At rest from demonic attacks and sicknesses. I want you to know that there is rest for you and Jesus is that rest. Shalom is in Jesus. Remember he said, *“These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world. (John 16:33 KJV)”* Jesus is your place of rest. The world that we live in doesn't have the ability to provide us secure rest because it is fallen. Yes there is some sort of rest from the world but its temporal. The rest

that you find in Jesus is eternal. God's peace which surpasses all knowledge (our imagination and all we can think of) shall be with you. You will walk in wholeness in your mind and body.

I am at rest in my life because I am in Christ. The peace of God guides my heart and I walk in peace even as I walk in love.

# Love is the way to peace

**A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.**

**(John 13:34 KJV)**

*Friday July 9*

I will start by sharing a quote;

“Love supplies but Sin demands.  
True peace and fulfillment is found when we walk in love”

Most of the times the reason why we fail to walk in love is because it seems like walking in love is unfair. A guy just said bad stuff about you and the next day he is lingering around your perimeter hoping for your help. Don't be afraid to walk in love. The more you walk in love the more you will experience peace in your life and the more also you will be able to radiate peace into other peoples lives.

I walk in love in Jesus name. My love for others is not based on what I receive from them but its unconditional. I love my mother, brother, sister and father just because I love them the same way God loves me just because he loves me.

# How to walk in love (A new commandment)

**A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.**

**(John 13:34 KJV)**

*Saturday July 10*

We need to be very conscious and attentive to every word especially when Jesus is talking because we might miss something important. There are three revelation that Jesus gave us in that scripture on how to walk in love. I know that probably you have been reading this scripture for quit a time and the only thing that your saw there was Jesus giving us a commandment to love us but that's not all he said there, he also showed how we can walk in it. The first key phrase is "A new commandment". If Jesus

says, “A new commandment I give unto you”, it means this was never declared under the Law and neither had he spoken of it in his ministry on earth until this time. God did speak about loving your neighbour as **yourself** but he never spoke about loving one another **the same way he loves us**. So the law was all about man working ( love your neighbour as yourself) but grace is all about God working ( love your neighbour as God loves you). The second thing; I want to understand that though Jesus spoke this commandment under the old testament ( Jesus hadn't died yet when he said this so it was still the old testament). The apostles had to wait for the resurrection of Christ for them to be able to fulfil and walk in this commandment. The reason why I say so is because this commandment is meant for a born again person. Jesus was commanding us to walk in the God-kind of love when he said it. But it would have been unjust of Jesus to tell us to walk in this commandment if he wasn't going to resurrect from the dead because we were already failing to keep the law which says love your neighbour as yourself. You might say brother Joseph I love my neighbour as myself. If you say that leaning on the law you are lying and deceiving yourself because the Law itself testifies that no one was

able to keep it {Psalms 14:1-3}. God himself testifies that all the children of Israel broke the first covenant {Jeremiah 31:31-32}. Paul himself testifies that it's impossible to be justified by the law {Galatians 2:16}. The first step you can take to walk in love is to allow Jesus to give you the authority to be called a child of God. When you become a child of God you inherit the DNA of God and we know that if God is love then all those who are born of God also love {1 John 4-7}. Simply say, "Jesus I make you my Lord. I believe you were raised from the dead. In your name I pray amen" If you have said that prayer you are now a child of God and you can walk in love because you are born of God.

### Prayer

I can walk in love because I am born of God. Thank you Jesus for resurrecting from the dead with me. I am born again because God raised me with you at the cross so that I can walk in the newness of life.

# How to walk in Love ( As I have loved you)

**A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.**

**(John 13:34 KJV)**

*Sunday July 11*

I promised to share three revelations that will allow us to walk in Love and yesterday I shared one of them. Forgive me for not following the order of the sentence in our theme scripture but the second revelation I want unveil is the one I highlighted last in that sentence. I am doing that so that you can easily follow up. Jesus didn't just tell us to love others but he told us to love them the same way he loves us. Our key phrase today is, "As I have loved you". Most of the times people criticize ministries which talk

about God's love and grace more but less about the sinfulness of man. Usually we think that if we tell a man how sinful he is or how he has to work to find God's approval that will empower him to walk in righteousness. If you think that I don't blame you but I do want you to know that that's not gospel preaching. Jesus here tells us that I am commanding you to love one another the same way I love you. This means if you don't have a revelation of how much Jesus loves you, you will never be able to love your brother with the same love that Jesus has for you. This is why we preach peace instead of condemnation, hope instead of judgement and God's grace and love. It is only when you know how much Jesus loves you that you can walk in the same kind of love and God loves you my brother and sister. This is why you have to continue to behold at Jesus and his grace and love for you.

### Prayer

I have a Father who loves me. Praise be to God who has made me acceptable in the beloved.

# How to walk in love (That ye love)

**A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another.**

**(John 13:34 KJV)**

*Monday July 12*

Today I am unveiling the last revelation on how to walk in Love. The key phrase today is, “That ye love”. I have already shared that you have the ability to love the same way as Jesus because you are born of God. I have already shared that for you to love others the same way Jesus loves you listen more to messages which preach about God’s love and grace. When Jesus gave us the commandment to walk in love he was saying, “I love you and you are able to show the same love I am showing you but now walk worthy of

your calling.” You need to understand that God has given you everything to live a godly but its now up to you to believe and walk in that reality. Confess everyday that I walk in love even as Jesus loved me. You might still feel less of what you are confessing but the more you profess it and walk in this truth as your reality you will see yourself walking in holiness and righteousness which is by faith in Jesus.

I walk in love even as Jesus loved me. I am child of God and if so I am an expression of God’s love in this world.

# God's heart is at you being whole

**Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.**

**(1 Peter 2:24 KJV)**

*Tuesday July 13*

God's heart is at you being whole. That's why Jesus went through the scrounging and pain so that you can know that by his strips you are healed. The healing there is not only talking about our bodies but minds. Remember scripture says Jesus healed all that vexed with unclean spirits. For someone who is going through depression or you are on a mental breakdown I want you to know that Jesus was crushed and afflicted at the cross emotionally and mentally so that you can experience peace in your

emotions and mind. Isaiah the prophet said this when he saw the glory of Jesus; *“He shall see of the **travail of his soul**, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.(Isaiah 53:11 KJV)”* The function of the soul is will, mind and emotions. Jesus saw the travail of his soul and yet he was pleased and satisfied because he saw you healing and redemption coming. This doesn’t mean if Jesus was satisfied he didn’t feel the pain. Remember Jesus prayed in Gethsemane saying, “if it were possible let this cup pass me {Matthew 26-38-38}.” Jesus felt all the pain and pressure but either way he didn’t look at his pain but at the glory that would follow. Paul later on testified this by saying, *“looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; **who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross**, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 12:2 KJV)”* Hallelujah! Jesus endured the cross because of his love for you and even as he was suffering he looked towards the healing and redemption you would receive through his work.

*Prayer*

Jesus was crushed and smitten so that I can be whole and at peace. I walk in a sound mind in Jesus name.

*Word Power*

Hebrews 5:7-10



# He paid the price

**Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.**

**(Isaiah 53:4-5 KJV)**

*Wednesday July 14*

Jesus paid for your healing as much as he paid for your sins. God tells us that Jesus was smitten, stricken and wounded and all of that was so that you receive forgiveness and the healing of God. Child of God your Father takes your health as one of his highest priority. If you were to study more about the old testament you will see that of all the sacrificial animals killed non of them was tortured. They were killed fast and they died a silent death and these were a type of Jesus. Why then did Jesus go through the chastisement and affliction? It was so that you

may know that by his strips you are healed. Jesus took your sicknesses and pain. If you are battling a disease in your life I just want you to confess and say, "Jesus I believe you took away my sins and sickness. I receive your healing in your name" Even if you don't feel any different as yet continue to speak words of faith. Continue to declare that I am healed in Jesus name.

Prayer

I walk in health in Jesus name. Jesus took away both my sins and sicknesses at the cross. I am free from sickness and depression. I walk in peace in Jesus name.

# Medicine is in line with

## God's purpose

**But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him, and went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him.**

**(Luke 10:33-34 KJV)**

*Thursday July 15*

This one of the accounts were Jesus talked about medicine and according to his words Jesus is saying medicine in line with my purpose. I am writing this devotion because usually when people hear about divine healing they sometimes develop a mentality that healing is only divine when I see it in church or when God does something miraculous, when God is actually using doctors to carry out a divine purpose. Jesus in our scripture tells us that I

am for medicine. He used this phrase , **“and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine”**. Wine is a antiseptic and oil is a lubricant. Oil also helps in keeping the wounds moist so they don’t dry up. This is the same work that doctors do today. They treat us and help in restoring and fixing problems that might be in our bodies that we don’t know how to fix. Jesus in that scripture includes the practise of medicine as something that helped in fulling a divine purpose. So don’t be afraid of medicine saying its against God’s divine healing. God might choose to use a doctor to minister to you healing and even when you go through operation we can trust in God that he will be with the doctor in the surgery empowering him do his purpose well.

### Prayer

I thank you Father for such wonderful revelations. My mind is transformed day by day as I learn more new truths about your will and word upon my life.

# **Rest in his grace and love**

## **for you**

**There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.**

**(Romans 8:1 KJV)**

*Friday July 16*

Usually the devil can use condemnation to bring things like sicknesses into our lives. Have you ever heard that voice after you have sinned that says, "You have sinned, you have sinned, you have sinned" That voice is not from God. The Holy spirit does correct us when we sin and he might do that by reminding you what he says in his word but the Holy Spirit will never condemn you. I will say this again the Holy Spirit will never condemn you. Already God is saying there is no longer any condemnation at all on

you. People suffer things like depression and I have heard of some who ended up having a mental breakdown because they were being haunted by thoughts of condemnation. Hebrews 10:14-18

# Faith for healing

**But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.**

**(Matthew 9:22 KJV)**

*Saturday July 17*

Most people ask themselves how do I get faith to be healed. This is what the scripture says; *“How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? (Romans 10:14 KJV)”*. You get faith for healing through hearing the gospel. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God. The reason why Jesus would say your faith has made you whole is because God has already made a provision for our healing ( all of us) the same way that God made a provision for our salvation and forgiveness of sins but not

all are saved but those who believe. The one who now has to play a role for healing to be experience is not God but its you. God has already made a provision for you healing. You are the one who now has to receive what God has given you by faith. That's why Jesus would say your faith has made you whole because as far as God is concerned he has made a provision for everyone's healing but only those who believe experience the blessing. I hope this answered you why many people are sick when God is so loving. The issue is not with God. What these people need, is to hear the gospel and believe in it so they can posses what God provided by Christ 2000 years ago.

# The prayer of faith

**And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.**

**(James 5:15 KJV)**

*Sunday July 18*

The prayer of faith shall save the sick. What then is a prayer of faith? There are two words to talk about, 'prayer' and 'faith'. Prayer in simple terms is to communicate with God while faith is the evidence of things not seen. Child of God I want you to know that God has already made a provision for your healing. Christ not only bore your sins but your sickness also at the cross. The prayer of faith is not a prayer of request but a prayer of receiving. In others words God is saying I have already made you whole by the strips of Jesus and all I am waiting for is for you to receive that blessing. If you are sick I want you to know that Jesus Christ was crucified for your healing. God is simply

waiting for you to receive your healing. Simply pray and say, "Father I receive your healing which was purchased by the strips that fell on Jesus. I am healed in Jesus name Amen" If your were sick and made that prayer I believe the Holy Spirit is bearing witness to your confession right now. I believe the Holy Spirit is restoring every broken and wounded area in you heart or body. You are healed Hallelujah!

I walk in health because Jesus was crushed, bruised and wounded for both my sins and sickness. He was wounded for my transgression and by his strips I am healed.

# **Proclaim the gospel of Christ and break free from condemnation and sickness**

**And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.**

**(James 5:15 KJV)**

*Monday July 19*

There is a strong connection between healing and the forgiveness of sins and we see it throughout the New Testament. The word salvation used in the New Testament most of the times is the word 'soteria' which is an all encompassing word which means, healing, deliverance, protection and preservation. James tells us that if a person makes a prayer of faith he will be healed and continues to say if he or she has committed sins they will be forgiven of

him. What interests me is the way that James connects prayer, faith, healing and forgiveness of sins. I submit to you that when James spoke about the prayer of faith he was talking about a prayer of proclaiming Jesus and his finished work at the cross. Whether you are a believer or not I want you to know that Jesus Christ paid for you healing and all you have to do is receive it. The reason why James said when you make a prayer of faith you will be healed and if you have committed sins they will be forgiven you is because it's impossible to make a prayer of faith without having heard and believed the gospel. A prayer of faith is a prayer of proclaiming the Lord's work at the cross. When you say I am healed because by his trips I'm healed; that's a prayer of faith. Proclaiming the finished work of Christ is what makes you walk in forgiveness of sins. If you believe and walk in the reality that Jesus was crucified for my sins forever you will walk in peace and health.

*Prayer*

I proclaim the works of Jesus at the cross. Jesus took my place of judgments, sickness and death so that I can take his place of life and health in Jesus name Amen.

*Word Power*

2 Corinthians 4:13

# Discern the body

**For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.**

**(1 Corinthians 11:29-30 KJV)**

*Tuesday July 20*

Paul is saying the reason why these Christians are sick, weak and die prematurely is because when they came together partaking the communion they failed to discern the Lord's body. What then is to discern the Lord's body? I submit to you that this means to acknowledge what the body did for you at the cross. This means when you take the communion you have to do it in acknowledgement (remembrance) of what the body of Jesus and his blood accomplished for you at the cross. If taking the communion without discerning the body was the reason why people were sick this means taking the communion discerning the body and the finished works of Christ can

make us walk in health. Taking the communion is a way of proclaiming the Lord's death. If you are sick take the communion regularly which a revelation that yes I feel sick but as I take this communion I believe the body of Jesus was wounded for my transgressions. Even if you feel that you have sinned and you feel guilt overtaking your mind when you take the communion know that as you take it discerning what blood of Jesus has done for you, you proclaim the forgiveness of God in your life. The communion is the most powerful way of proclaiming our faith besides confession and what makes communion special is that we received it from Jesus himself. Jesus said this is how I want to be remembered.

### *Prayer*

My father I thank you for the blessing of the Holy communion. Lord Jesus I will always do this in remembrance of you.

# We need healing in our souls

**Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save (sozo) your souls.**

**(James 1:21 KJV)**

*Wednesday July 21*

The Greek word for the word 'save' is 'sozo' which is a word which means heal, preserve, deliver and protect. Most of the times when we talk about healing people think we only need healing in our bodies but God's word also says we need healing in our souls. Our souls receive healing through the word of God. God's word purifies our souls and cleanses them from all damage whether which was cause by our sins or the sins of the world around us. You might have not known it but sin affects your soul greatly. Not only when you sin do you damage your soul



but also being a victim of sinful activities can hurt you. A girl who was raped at the age of maybe 15 will probably have problems with her emotions and feelings not because she sinned but because she was a victims of a painful experience. God' words is the only thing that can give rest to our souls. As you walk under the Shepard-ship of Jesus through his word you will experience more peace and health in your emotions, will and mind.

### Prayer

Jesus was wounded for my transgression and by his strips I am healed. I was a sheep gone astray but now I have returned to the Shepard of my soul.

There are other ways disease may come but I wanted to emphasize more on those two. People who are in sports or celebrities are very careful about what they eat because they know that the kind of food they eat can affect their bodies negatively which might not be good for their career. There were times in my life when I tried to live a whole day without sinning. I would monitor every word I spoke. I would monitor my whole behaviour. Sometimes I would feel like today the day has passed by without living an unholy life. Just so you know if I see yourself as a Christian relying more on feelings when it comes to things which concern the Lord (righteous and holiness), this might be a sure sign that you are not walking by faith. Funny thing scripture never said the just shall live by feelings but it said the just shall live by faith {Habakkuk 2:4}. Secondly

you can't please God by feelings {Hebrews 11:6}. Only those who walk by faith can please God. Paul also said this once. *"Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh, I more: circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, an Hebrew of the Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee; concerning zeal, persecuting the church; **touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless.** (Philippians 3:4-6 KJV)"*

Even Paul during the times when he lived his life according to the flesh ( feelings and not faith) leaning on the Law he had some sense of holiness. He actually testifies himself that, *'as touching the righteousness which is by the law, blameless'*. I want you to know that the law can never produce true holiness. Leaning on the Law will only give you a falsified impression that you are holy. Child of God I want you to lean on what the blood has done for you instead of your works. You are forgiven because of the blood of Jesus. We have boldness to stand in the holy of holies not by our works but by the blood of Jesus {Hebrews 10:19}. Instead trying to please God by works, rest in what the blood of Jesus has done for you. If you rest



in what Christ did at the cross you will see that even your works will be transformed.

*Prayer*

I have redemption, “the forgiveness” through the blood of Jesus. I am forgiveness eternally through the blood of Jesus which speaks better things than the blood of Abel.

# **Delivered from Sin, Poverty, Sickness and Death**

**Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness,  
and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear  
Son:**

**(Colossians 1:13)**

*Sunday July 25*

Some people attack preachers who preach to people that through Christ believers were delivered from poverty. I want you to know that by the death and resurrection of Christ we were delivered from the work of the devil which is Sin. You need understand that in the will of God there is no such thing as poverty. That's why you see that even

when the Lord made the heavens and the earth Adam and Eve were living in abundance. They had everything they could wish for and God was with them as they enjoyed everything that God had made for them in his presence. Things like lack, poverty, sickness and death came after the fall (after man had sinned). But Christ came to destroy sin; “For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil {1 John 3:8}”. He came to destroy sin, sickness, poverty and death. And since we are no longer living according to the will of the devil but of God we should walk in health, prosperity, joy and righteousness. So be conscious that you are dead to sin and have been translated into the kingdom of Christ where you cannot suffer lack and be sick. Refuse to settle for something that is not the will of God upon your life.

We give thanks unto you God by Jesus Christ our Lord who has delivered us from the power of darkness and has translated us into his kingdom. I am free from death, sin, poverty and sickness in the name of Jesus.

# Receive healing

**Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them.**

**(Luke 4:40 KJV)**

This was during the ministry of Jesus as he was with us on earth. Jesus would heal the sick, cast out demons and the like. He was the source of Hope in a dark and desperate world. Many would come to him who had lost hope, who had become outcasts in their society. Lepers would approach Jesus, the blind would cry out to him. Truly he was a light that shined in the darkness. In Mark the scripture ends by saying this, *“So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. And they went forth, and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen (Mark 16:19-20 KJV).”*

So though Jesus was now in heaven he was still working miracles and he was still healing the sick. Miracles were happening. The sick were being healed. In the Acts of the Apostles we hear the wonderful news of how people were being healed by the hands of the Apostles. I want you to know my brother and sister that Jesus is still healing today and by his strips you are healed. Jesus has already paid for your healing that's why scripture says he was wounded for our transgressions and by his strips we are healed {1 Peter 2:24}. So just lay your hand on where ever you feel pain and just declare that in Jesus name I am healed. Even if there are wounds in your relationships with your loved ones, children or mentally you are battling with something by the strips of Jesus you are healed and delivered from anything that was keeping you in bondage.

I walk in health in Jesus name. Father thank you for the death of Christ which bought forgiveness and healing in our souls and body, in Jesus name Amen.

There is power in words. What you believe and what you confess matters in life. Paul is saying we have the same Spirit of faith believing we speak. You confess what you believe and you need to hear or read the word to believe the right things. I know most of you have heard about the doctrine of confession. It's not just a matter of confessing but it's about a confession that is coming from a believing heart. That's why Paul is saying 'we believe also (1), and



therefore speak (2).’ I know that you have been hearing the beautiful promises about God's healing in your life. The Bible is full of scriptures which prove that God wants you to walk in health. You now need to activate what you believe in through confession. Always speak life and health in your life. There is the power of life and death in the tongue {Proverbs 18:21}. What you speak can either transform your life or pull it down. I will share one last revelation.

Let’s take a closer look to what Paul said; “I believed, and therefore have I spoken; **we also believe, and therefore speak; knowing** that he which raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also by Jesus, and shall present us with you.” We don’t just confess but we confess **knowing** what Christ did at cross. In other words when we confess our faith we are proclaiming the cross. Take time to utilize the word based confessions in this devotional also. At every Prayer section there is ether a word based prayer or proclamation.

# The genetics of words

**Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they turned about with a very small helm, whithersoever the governor listeth. Even so the tongue is a little member,.....**

**(James 3:4-5)**

*Wednesday July 28*

The ship is controlled by a small helm (a small lever usually at the back of the ship). To those who watch movies or who have board an actual ship I'm sure you might have seen it. Its definitely less than 1% percent of the ship's total volume yet it can turn the whole ship. James compares our tongues as this lever. Though our tongues are very small they can turn and shape our destinies in a huge way. If what we speak is very important it means we have to understand the genetics of words. The bible even says death and life is in the power of the tongue {Proverbs 18:21}. Big question then, "How

do we change our way of speaking from destructive to life giving words?" We change our words by changing what is in our heart. Wow, isn't it? I'm sure you didn't expect that one. This is what Jesus said; *"A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: **for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh.** (Luke 6:45 KJV)".* You don't change your words by trying to force yourself to speak good things. You change your words by changing what's in your heart. Two things are needed for you to speak life. Firstly you need to make Jesus your Lord if you haven't yet to receive a new heart according to what God says in his word {Ezekiel 36:26}. Secondly you need to walk in the truth of the gospel this includes the believer. In other words you need to let the word of God flow into your heart. Be careful what you allow into your heart when you watch movies, listen to music and even when choosing friends to hang around with. I am not saying don't love believers but I am saying don't be unequally yoked with them. When your heart is full of the word of God and good things you will see life giving words naturally coming out of your mouth.

I speak life giving words. I am not unequally yoked with unbelievers but I meditate on the word of God. My speech gives life to all that hear me and to everything I do in Jesus name Amen.
